**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 172-1999**

**To amend further By-law No. 271, a by-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule II of By-law No. 271, a By-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways,” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words where they appear in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Column 1 Highway	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Prohibited Months
Donlands Avenue	West	Mortimer Avenue and the South Borough Limit	January, March, May, July, September and November
Donlands Avenue	East	Mortimer Avenue and the South Borough Limit	February, April, June, August, October and December

2. Schedule II of By-law No. 271, a By-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways,” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Dewhurst Boulevard North” and “Don Valley Drive”, the following:

Column 1 Highway	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Prohibited Months
Donlands Avenue	West	Sammon Avenue and a point 37.4 metres south of the south curb line of Somers Avenue	January, March, May, July, September and November
Donlands Avenue	East	Sammon Avenue and a point 37.4 metres south of the south curb line of Somers Avenue	February, April, June, August, October and December

**3.** This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
