CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 185-1999

To amend Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto to restrict the operating hours for boulevard cafes located on Queen Street East, between Coxwell Avenue and Victoria Park Avenue.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act* and the *City of Toronto Act, 1993(No. 3)* provide City Council with the authority to issue licenses for the purposes of boulevard cafes and impose terms and conditions upon the use of such licensed areas, which may vary by location; and

WHEREAS City Council has directed that boulevard cafes currently operating without time restrictions previously imposed by Council and located on Queen Street East between Coxwell Avenue and Victoria Park Avenue shall, except on special event days, be closed and cleared by 11:00 p.m.;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Municipal Code of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto is amended by adding a new subsection to § 313-36 as follows:

- F.1 (1) In addition to the provisions set out in Subsection E, where a boulevard cafe is located on the Queen Street East frontage, between Coxwell Avenue and Victoria Park Avenue, the agreement shall be deemed to include the requirement that the owner or occupant ensure that the cafe is closed and cleared by 11:00 p.m.
- (2) The restriction on the hours of operation as set out in Subsection F.1(2) shall not apply:
- (a) Where Council has imposed a specific closing time restriction on an affected cafe.
 - (b) On special event days as determined by the Commissioner.
