CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 208-1999

To name the private lane at premises 322 Clinton Street “Nancy Pocock Place”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The lane as shown on the attached Map “A” dated February, 1999 is named “Nancy Pocock Place”.
- 2.** MCJ Development Consultants, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
- 3.** MCJ Development Consultants, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed pursuant to section 2 of this by-law.

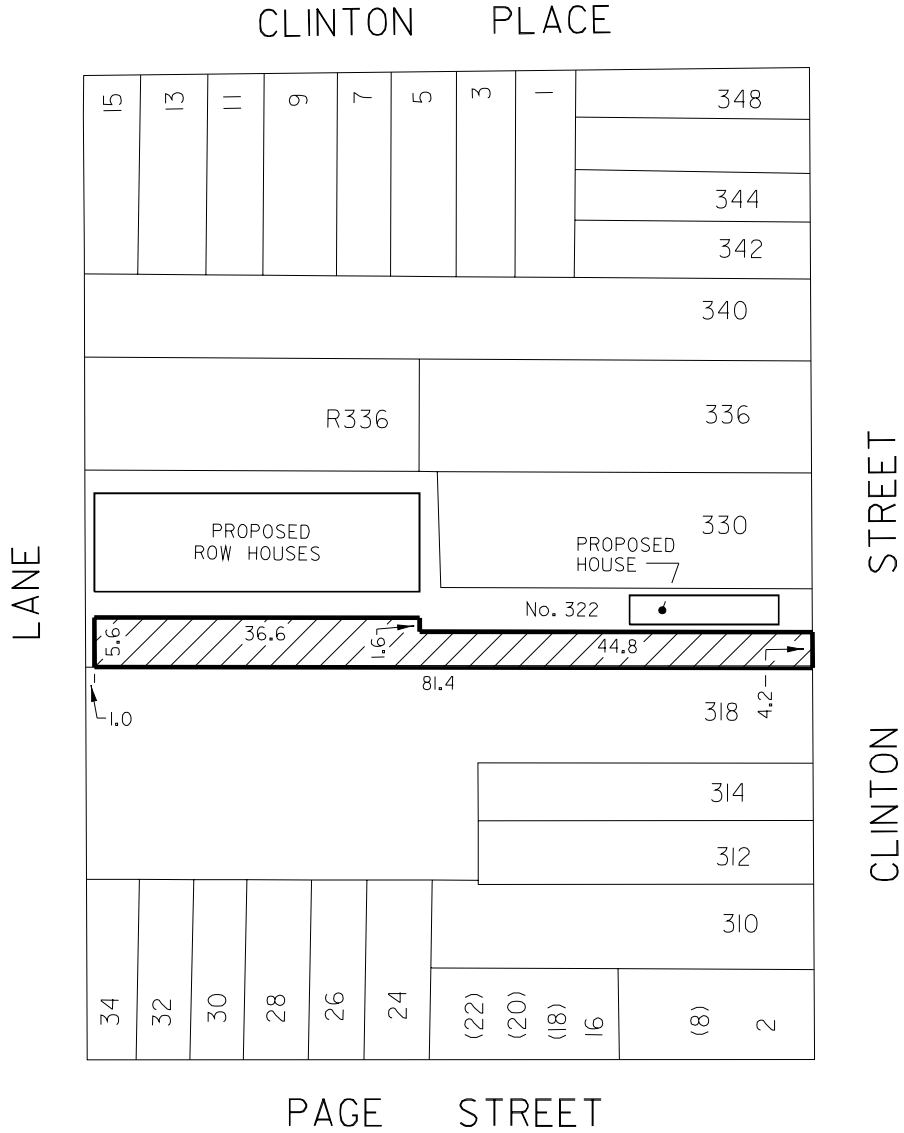

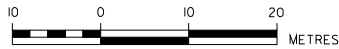
