CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 211-1999

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Sheppard Avenue (M.T. 28)	Both	Yonge Street and Easton Road	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 28)	South	Easton Road and Beecroft Road	Anytime
Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 28)	North	Easton Road and Yonge Street	Anytime

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Sheppard Avenue (M.T. 28)	South	The easterly limit of Beecroft Road and the westerly limit of Doris Avenue	Anytime

3. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Sheppard Avenue (M.T. 28)	South	Yonge Street and Doris Avenue	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule.
