CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 220-1999

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 165, Development of Land, to
include automobile service stations under site plan control.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 165-36 of Chapter 165, Development of Land, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto is amended by deleting § 165-36.A.(1) and substituting therefor the following:

- (1) The erection of a mixed-use building or a non-residential building where the gross floor area of the building is not more than three hundred (300) square metres but excluding the erection of an automobile service station on a lot other than in a T, Tr, IC, I1, I2, I3 or I4 district as designated by By-law No. 438-86.
