**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 244-1999**

**To amend further By-law No. 20-85, a by-law  
"Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing  
of trades, callings, businesses and occupations  
in the Metropolitan Area", being a by-law of the former  
Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Subsection 1(25) and section 4 of By-law No. 20-85, a By-law "Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area", as amended, being a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, are repealed.

**2.** Subsection 1(23) of By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is repealed and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

(23) "Executive Director" means the Executive Director of the Municipal Licensing and Standards Division, of the Urban Planning and Development Services Department, of the City of Toronto.

**3.** By-law No. 20-85, as amended, and all Schedules thereto, as amended, are further amended by deleting the words "General Manager" wherever they appear therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Executive Director".

**4.** By-law No. 20-85, as amended, and all Schedules thereto, as amended, are further amended by deleting the words "Manager of Issuing" wherever they appear therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Executive Director or his or her designate".

**5.** This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on March 15, 1999.
