**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 256-1999**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic  
on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

Eglinton Avenue East and Lebovic Avenue (M.T. 18)	Eglinton Avenue East and a point 30.5 metres west thereof	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning (buses excepted)
