**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 287-1999**

**To amend By-law No. 64-87, a By-law “For  
Prohibiting and Regulating the Erection of Signs  
and Other Advertising Devices”, being a by-law of  
the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** By-law No. 54-87, a By-law “For Prohibiting and Regulating the Erection of Signs or Other Advertising Devices” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting Article 4.2.5. following Article 4.2.4. as follows:

“4.2.5. Notwithstanding Sentence 4.2.1.(c), the following sign, as shown on the drawings prepared by Zip Signs in Burlington, Ontario date stamped received, October 28, 1998, shall be permitted to be installed for Goodwill, located at the property known as 3003 Danforth Avenue, in the year 1999.

- (a) one (1) facial sign with an overall height of 3.65 metres (12'-0"), displaying the Goodwill Logo, on the north elevation, facing Danforth Avenue.”
