BY-LAW No. 362-1999

To lay out and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of Sheppard Avenue West.

WHEREAS as a result of an application for access for premises 48 Kodiak Crescent (1150 Sheppard Avenue West) as authorized by the former Metropolitan Toronto Council authority allowing the acceptance lands abutting Metropolitan Roads for road widenings;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Sheppard Avenue West, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10177-0038 (LT).

Being part of Block 26 (Reserve) on Plan M-1982 designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-18155 both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

The northeasterly limit of Sheppard Avenue West as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-217, registered as Plan 9042 (Instrument 606784).

In the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario.

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Sheppard Avenue West.
