BY-LAW No. 425-1999

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words where they appear in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Prohibited Times & Days
Dunkirk Road	South	Binswood Avenue and Glebemount Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday inclusive

2. Schedule VIII of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Douglas Crescent” and “Dunkirk Road” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Highway	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Time or Days
Dunkirk Road	South	Binswood Avenue and a point 40.0 metres east of Binswood Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday inclusive
Dunkirk Road	South	A point 45.8 metres east of Binswood Avenue and Glebemount Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday inclusive

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
