BY-LAW No. 473-1999

**To stop up and close the public lane between Lots 73 and 74 on Plan 1665, York,
west of 2620 St. Clair Avenue West, and to authorize the sale thereof.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane between Lots 73 and 74 on Plan 1665, York, west of 2620 St. Clair Avenue West, be stopped up and closed as a public lane and be sold on terms and conditions to be determined by Council; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the said portion of public lane and to authorize the sale thereof was published in the Toronto Star on June 24, June 30, July 7 and July 14, 1999;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane between Lots 73 and 74 on Plan 1665, York, west of 2620 St. Clair Avenue West, described as follows:

In the City of Toronto (formerly the City of York) and Province of Ontario, being composed of the Public Lane dedicated by The Corporation of the Township of York By-law 14866 SECONDLY (Instrument York 378323) being parts of Lots 73 and 74 according to Plan 1665, the said Plan and Instrument being registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64)

is hereby stopped up and closed as a public lane.

2. The soil and freehold of the public lane stopped up and closed by Section 1 of this By-law shall be sold on terms and conditions to be determined by Council.
