CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 477-1999

To amend further By-law No. 20-85, a by-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area”, being a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, respecting Massagists and Massage Parlours.

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsections 1(27) and 2(26) of By-law No. 20-85, being a by-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area”, a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, as amended, are repealed.

2. Schedule 1 to By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is further amended by deleting the following under the columns indicated:

3. Schedule 17 to By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is repealed.
