CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 527-1999

To further amend Interim Purchasing By-law No. 57-1998 to permit the Bid Committee to award certain contracts during the summer recess of Council.

WHEREAS the Bid Committee is authorized to award contracts valued at a maximum amount of \$1 million and Standing Committees of Council are authorized to award contracts valued between the amounts of \$1 million and \$2.5 million; and

WHEREAS Council and its Standing Committees have a summer recess during which time it may be necessary to award contracts valued in excess of \$1 million and less than \$2.5 million in order to ensure those contracts are not subject to unnecessary delays; and

WHEREAS Council is authorizing the Bid Committee to award contracts valued between \$1 million and \$2.5 million during the summer recess of Council and to report back to Council through the Administration Committee, on the contracts awarded during the summer recess;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Interim Purchasing By-law No. 57-1998, being a by-law “To establish interim procedures and authority for the procurement of goods and services”, is further amended by adding the following new Section 6.1 after Section 6:

6.1 Bid Committee - Extended Authority - Summer Recess of Council

- (1) During the period between July 14, 1999 and September 8, 1999, the Bid Committee is authorized to exercise the powers of a Standing Committee set out in subsection 6(3) above.
- (2) Where the Bid Committee has made an Award under subsection 6.1(1), the Award shall be reported to Council through the Administration Committee.

2. This By-law is repealed at 12:01 a.m. on September 8, 1999.
