BY-LAW No. 545-1999

To layout and dedicate for public highway purposes certain land to form part of Lorindale Avenue.

WHEREAS By-law No. 13466 established a one-foot reserve strip across the north end of Lorindale Avenue to be held by the City until required for the further northerly extension of Lorindale Avenue; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate to layout and dedicate the one-foot reserve to form part of Lorindale Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land at the north limit of Lorindale Avenue, described by Wally Kowalenko, City Surveyor, O.L.S., as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of that part of the northerly One Foot of Lot 1 according to Plan 1303Y bounded on the east by the northerly production of the easterly limit of Lorindale Avenue, dedicated by City of Toronto By-law 13466, and bounded on the west by the northerly production of the westerly limit of Lorindale Avenue, the said Plan being registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64),

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Lorindale Avenue.
