CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 599-1999

To authorize the removal of certain trees growing on the highways of the Municipality.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, Section 312, subsection 4(e) provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws causing any tree planted upon a highway within the municipality to be removed when considered necessary in the public interest; and

WHEREAS it is considered necessary in the public interest to cause the trees hereinafter designated, growing on the highways of the municipality, to be removed;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to cut down and remove, or cause to be cut down and removed, the trees standing in the following highways:

Guestville Avenue (8) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Linden tree. <i>Storm damage.</i>
Teston Boulevard (19) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Storm damage.</i>
Westbury (123) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Storm damage.</i>
Dennis Avenue (42) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Storm damage.</i>
Vaughan Road (377) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Manitoba Maple tree. <i>Storm damage.</i>
Arlington Avenue (531) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Hazardous split at main union.</i>
Kane Avenue (343) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Silver Maple tree. <i>Hazardous decay at base.</i>
Bridgeview Road (27) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Humbercrest (101) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>

Ravenal Street (5) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Rectory Road (1) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>In decline, extensive decay.</i>
Church Street (68) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Montye Avenue (18) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>In decline, half of tree is dead.</i>
Lonborough Avenue (70) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Spruce tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Belgravia Avenue (197) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	Two (2) Norway Maple trees. <i>Too close to house and high power lines. Misshaped, dead tree.</i>
Arlington Avenue (208) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Lilac tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Westmount Avenue (264) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Maplewood Avenue (100) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Spruce tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Kenwood Avenue (22) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Manitoba Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Rushton Road (312) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Silver Maple tree. <i>In decline, not maintainable.</i>
Walmer Road (400) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Sugar Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Brookside Avenue (122) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Split at main union.</i>
Winnett Avenue (76) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) White Oak tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Haverson Boulevard (68) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Manitoba Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>

Boyd Avenue (47) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Norway Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Boyd Avenue (44) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Locust tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Glamis Avenue (1) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Blue Spruce tree. <i>Tree is in very poor condition.</i>
Brookside Avenue (109) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Green Ash tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Lessard Avenue (25) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Red Oak tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
Westmount Avenue (463) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Columnar Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Regent Street (106) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Manitoba Maple tree. <i>Tree is in very poor condition.</i>
Keele Street (1693) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Manitoba Maple tree. <i>Dead tree.</i>
Rogers Road (554) <i>Reason for removal:</i>	One (1) Silver Maple tree. <i>Half of tree is dead.</i>
