**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 600-1999**

**To amend City of Etobicoke By-law No. 1980-69 being a By-law  
to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.**

WHEREAS Part XIX of the *Ontario Municipal Act* provides for penalties and enforcement of by-laws; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has the authority to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers; and

WHEREAS former City of Etobicoke By-Law No. 1980-69 appointed Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the former municipality; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto wishes to increase the number of Municipal Law Enforcement Officers;

Now therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Section 1 of By-law No. 1980-69, as amended, be further amended by adding thereto the following names:

Economic Development, Culture & Tourism  
(Parks & Recreation - West District)
