CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 612-1999

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Albany Avenue by the installation of speed humps from Bloor Street West to Barton Avenue.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on May 7, 11, 18, and 25, 1999 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 26, 1999 and a further public meeting held on September 14, 1999 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-4” (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:

(Column 1 Street)	(Column 2 Side/Corner)	(Column 3 Alteration/ Repair)	(Column 4 From)	(Column 5 To)	(Column 6 Drawing No./Date)
Albany Avenue		Alteration consisting of the installation of speed humps	Bloor Street West	Barton Avenue	421F-5274 dated October 1998
