**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 628-1999**

**To layout and dedicate certain land south of St. Clair Avenue West for  
public highway purposes to form part of Keele Street.**

WHEREAS former City of Toronto Council, by the enactment of Municipal Code, Chapter 165, Development of Land, Article IV, delegated to the Commissioner of Urban Development Services the authority to approve plans and drawings in relation to certain classes of development in areas of site plan control; and

WHEREAS as part of the former City of Toronto Commissioner of Urban Development Services' approval of plans for the development of 590 Keele Street it was deemed necessary to widen part of Keele Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Certain land south of St. Clair Avenue West to form part of the public highway Keele Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parcel E-4 in the Register for Section A-1542.

Being part of Block E on Plan 1542-York registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64) designated as PART 5 on Plan 66R-17150 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated to form part of Keele Street.
