CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 643-1999

To amend By-law No. 817-1998 to extend the period of interim control on certain lands zoned "Limited Institutional" in the Birchcliff Community Zoning By-law No. 8786.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto, at its meeting of October 28, 29 and 30, 1998 passed Interim Control By-law No. 817-1998; and

WHEREAS Section 38 of the Planning Act permits the Council of a municipality to pass a by-law prohibiting the use of land, buildings or structures within the defined area under review for, or except for, such purposes as are set out in the by-law and to amend the by-law to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has determined that Interim Control By-law No. 817-1998 should be extended as it applies to one of the affected sites for a six month period;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 817-1998 is hereby amended by deleting Sections No. 1. and 2. and replacing them as follows:

1. No person shall erect a Senior Citizen Home or Nursing Home on lands zoned "Limited Institutional" in the Birchcliff Community Zoning By-law No. 8786, being Block A, Registered Plan 3288, known municipally as 255 Blantyre Avenue, as shown on Schedule "1" attached.

2. This by-law shall be in effect for a period of 6 months from the 28th day of October, 1999.

ENACTED AND PASSED this 29th day of September, A.D. 1999.

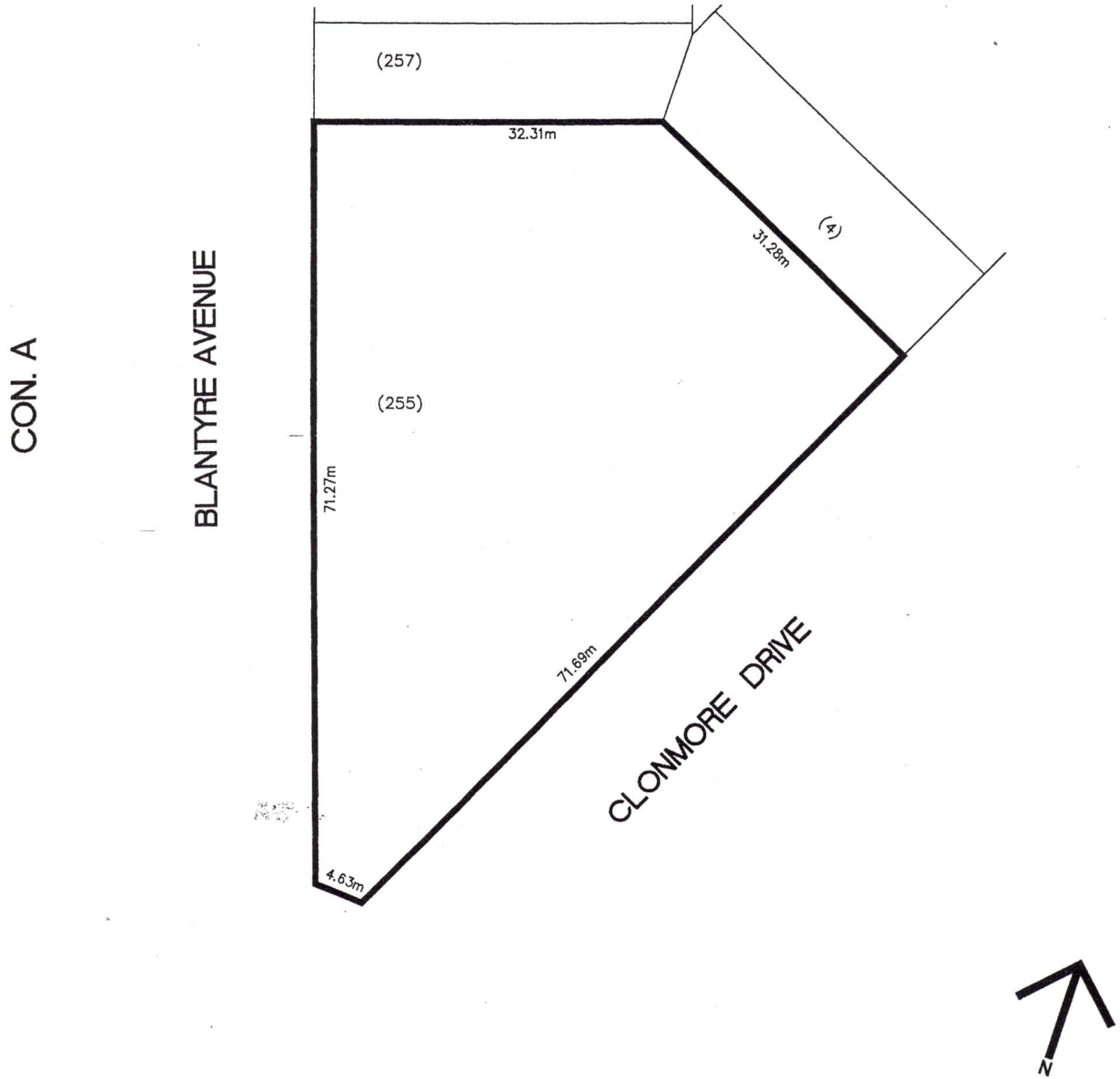
