**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 674-1999**

**To stop up and close the public lane 45.73 metres north of College Street, extending  
easterly from Huron Street and to authorize the sale thereof.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane 45.73 metres north of College Street,  
extending easterly from Huron Street be stopped up and closed as a public lane and be sold to the  
abutting owner on terms and conditions to be determined by City Council; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the lane and to authorize the  
sale thereof was published in the Toronto Star on October 5, 11, 18 and 25, 1999;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** The public lane 45.73 metres north of College Street, extending easterly from Huron  
Street, described as follows:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of the Public Lane  
on Plan D-217 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto  
Registry Division (No. 64)

is hereby stopped up and closed as a public lane.

**2.** The soil and freehold of the public lane stopped up and closed by Section 1 of this  
By-law shall be sold to the abutting owner on terms and conditions to be determined by Council.
