BY-LAW No. 733-1999

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Front Yard Parking.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By striking out §400-9D(4)(b) and §400-9D(4)(b.1) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(b) If the property is situated in Ward 19 (High Park), where the property is on the side of the street where permit parking is not authorized.

(b.1) If the property is within Ward 23 (Midtown), where the property is not located in an area or on a street authorized for permit parking pursuant to §400-38.”

B. By inserting a new Subsection (b.2) and a new Subsection (b.3) after Subsection (b.1) in §400-9D(4) of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, as follows:

“(b.2) If the property is situated in Ward 20 (Trinity-Niagara), where the property is situated on the side of the street where permit parking is not authorized or where the property is situated on the same side of the street as permit parking is authorized, notwithstanding that there are more spaces than permits issued, only where there is no other on-site parking. Subsection (4)(a.1) does not apply.

(b.3) If the property is situated in Ward 21, 22, or 26 (Davenport, North Toronto or East Toronto), where the property is situated on the side of the street where permit parking is not authorized or where the property is situated on the same side of the street as permit parking is authorized, where there are more spaces than permits issued. Subsection (4)(a.1) does not apply.”

2. The provisions of this By-law shall be deemed to have come into force effective March 4, 1999.
