BY-LAW No. 746-1999

**To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 673-1998, as amended, being a by-law
“To Prohibit Excessive Idling of Vehicles and Boats”.**

WHEREAS it is desirable to have reference to the Provincial Offences Act in the general penalty provision section of City of Toronto By-law No. 673-1998, as amended, being a by-law “To Prohibit Excessive Idling of Vehicles and Boats”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 3 of City of Toronto By-law No. 673-1998, as amended, being a by-law “To Prohibit Excessive Idling of Vehicles and Boats”, is further amended by deleting: “Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence.” and inserting in lieu thereof: “Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act”.
