CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 764-1999

To exempt part of the lands commonly known as Phase II of the Woodbine Park Development, being certain lots and blocks within Plan of Subdivision 66M-2332, from the provisions of subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act.

WHEREAS Subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. p.13, as amended, states that the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. p.13, as amended, does not apply to land that is within a registered plan of subdivision or part or parts thereof as are designated in such by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. p.13, as amended, shall not apply to the lands described in Schedule "A".
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 50(7.3) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. p.13, as amended, this By-law as it pertains to the blocks listed in (i) of Schedule "A" expires as of December 31, 2001.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 50(7.3) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. p.13, as amended, this By-law, as it pertains to the blocks listed in (ii) of Schedule "A" expires as of December 31, 2003.
