## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 778-1999**

#### **To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”.**

WHEREAS it is desirable to clarify City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”, so as to reflect that there shall be no blocking the passage of streetcars; and

WHEREAS it is desirable to have reference to the Provincial Offences Act in the general penalty provision section of City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”, is further amended by deleting Section 2 of the By-law and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“2. Despite any By-law of the City of Toronto, no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a street car track or park or stand a vehicle so as to block the passage of a streetcar on any highway set out in Column 1 of Schedule “B” to this By-law between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said schedule during the period of an emergency condition hereinafter referred to, where signs have been erected thereon.”

**2.** Section 8 of City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow” is amended by deleting: “Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence.” and inserting in lieu thereof: “Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act”.

**3.** The schedule in Subsection 9(1) of City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”, is amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said schedule the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Section 2	(Park/stand) so as to block the passage of a streetcar on snow route	150.00
