**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 782-1999**

**A By-law to appoint certain City of Toronto employees as  
Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.**

WHEREAS the Police Services Act provides that municipal councils may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality; and

WHEREAS Part II of the Provincial Offences Act empowers Provincial Offences Officers to issue Certificates of Parking Infraction and Parking Infraction Notices; and

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act provides that municipal law enforcement officers are empowered, upon the discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of a municipal by-law, to cause the vehicle to be moved or impounded; and

WHEREAS the Solicitor General of Ontario has designated all municipal law enforcement officers as Provincial Offences Officers; and

WHEREAS the City of Toronto's Works and Emergency Services Department has requested that certain of its staff members be appointed municipal law enforcement officers for the purposes of becoming authorized to issue Certificates of Parking Infraction and Parking Infraction Notices under the Provincial Offences Act, and, pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act, for the purpose of authorizing the moving and impounding of vehicles found in breach of City of Toronto by-laws;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** As used in this by-law, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

(a) "Boulevard" means that part of any highway between the curb or edge of roadway and the highway line, exclusive of the area covered by sidewalk.

(b) "Certified Officer (Parking Offences)" means any person listed in Schedule "A" to this by-law and who has been or who is hereafter certified by the Chief of the Toronto Police Service as competent for the purposes of enforcing one or more municipal parking by-laws within the City of Toronto or any specified part or parts thereof for any period set out in the certificate and whose certificate has not lapsed or been suspended or cancelled by the Chief.

2. Every Certified Officer (Parking Offences) is hereby appointed a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the purpose of issuing Certificates of Parking Infraction and Parking Infraction Notices under Part II of the Provincial Offences Act for the purpose of enforcing City of Toronto by-laws respecting parking or standing of vehicles on highways during snow removal and by-laws respecting parking or standing of vehicles on boulevards, and authorizing the moving, towing, and impounding of vehicles found parked, left, stopped, or standing in contravention of those by-laws, pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act.
