CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 868-1999

To stop up and close part of the public highway Wilson Heights Boulevard north of Sheppard Avenue West and to authorize the sale thereof.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway Wilson Heights Boulevard north of Sheppard Avenue West be stopped up and closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner on terms and conditions to be determined by Council; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the said portion of the public highway and to authorize the sale thereof was published in The Globe and Mail on November 22, November 29, December 6 and December 13, 1999;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Wilson Heights Boulevard north of Sheppard Avenue West, described as follows:

Part of PIN 10172-0145 R

In the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of the Public Highway Wilson Heights Boulevard dedicated by City of North York By-law Number 30805 (TB617552), the said part of Wilson Heights Boulevard being part of Lot 16 in Concession 2 West of Yonge Street, designated as Part 3 on a Plan of survey deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64) as RS-1060

is hereby stopped up and closed as a public highway.

2. The soil and freehold of the portion of public highway stopped up and closed by Section 1 of this By-law shall be sold to the abutting owner on terms and conditions to be determined by Council.
