BY-LAW No. 870-1999

**To make a technical amendment to By-law 661-1999, a By-law “To fix the rates for the
supply of water and sewer services by the City of Toronto”.**

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council enacted By-law No. 661-1999 at its meeting held on
September 28 and 29, 1999; and

WHEREAS section 5 of the by-law refers to flat rate consumers in the former City of
Toronto paying the combined Water Rates and Sewer Service Rates as set out in Schedules “B”,
“C” and “D” to the said by-law or as set out in By-law No. 356-1998 when the Schedules and
By-law No. 356-1998 in fact reference the applicability of water rates only to flat rate customers;
and

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend section 5 to accurately reflect the intent of Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 5 of By-Law No. 661-1999 is hereby amended by:
 - (a) striking out the words “combined Water Rate and Sewer Service Rate” in
paragraph 5(i) and replacing the words with the words “rates for water”,
 - (b) inserting the word “metered” before the word “consumers” in both
paragraphs 5(ii) and 5(iii); and
 - (c) striking out the words “combined Water Rates and Sewer Service Rates”
in paragraph 5(iv) and replacing the words with the words “rates for
water”,

so that Section 5 of By-Law No. 661-1999 shall now read as follows:

“5. Water shall be supplied by the City of Toronto to consumers in the former City of
Toronto on the terms and conditions set out in Chapter 340 of the Municipal Code of the
former City of Toronto except as follows:

- (i) Prior to January 1, 2000, metered and flat rate consumers shall continue to
pay the rates for water set out in By-law No. 356-1998.

- (ii) Commencing January 1, 2000, in respect of water accounts not paid on or before the Due Date, metered consumers shall pay a combined Water Rate and Sewer Service Rate of \$1.1040 per cubic metre of water used or fraction thereof, or \$5.0189 per 1000 imperial gallons or fraction thereof.
- (iii) Commencing January 1, 2000, in respect of water accounts paid on or before the Due Date, metered consumers shall pay a combined Water Rate and Sewer Service rate of \$1.0514 per cubic metre of water used or fraction thereof, or \$4.7798 per 1000 imperial gallons or fraction thereof.
- (iv) Commencing January 1, 2000, the flat rate consumers in the former City of Toronto shall pay the rates for water as set out in the attached Schedules "B", "C" and "D" to this By-law".
