**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 890-1999**

**To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”, is further amended by deleting Subsection 11(2) of City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(2) In the event of any conflict between any one or more of the other Snow Emergency By-laws and this By-law, this By-law shall govern”.

2. Section 1 of this By-law shall be effective on the earlier of:

- (a) the date that the City Solicitor files a notice in the office of the City Clerk that the City of Toronto has received from the Regional Senior Justice of the Ontario Court of Justice approved set fines for the offences set out in City of Toronto By-law No. 528-1999, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on certain highways during periods of emergency occasioned by the fall of snow”; and
- (b) February 4, 2000.
