**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 18-2000**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic  
on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Queen Street East and Eastern Avenue	The west curb line of Eastern Avenue and a point 60 metres west of the west curb line of Eastern Avenue	Northerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound left- turning
Queen Street East and Kingston Road	The east curb line of Kingston Road and a point 150 metres east thereof	Southerly Westbound	Anytime	Westbound left-turning
