CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 56-2000

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane system west of Lightbourn Avenue extending between Chandos Avenue and Beaver Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane system west of Lightbourne Avenue extending between Chandos Avenue and Beaver Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 14 in Block F on Plan 646-York designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-15539, both said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64).

is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
