CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 60-2000

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane system in the block bounded by Davenport Road, Bedford Road and Dupont Street.

WHEREAS former City of Toronto Council, by the enactment of Municipal Code, Chapter 165, Development of Land, Article IV, delegated to the Commissioner of Urban Development Services the authority to approve plans and drawings in relation to certain classes of development in areas of site plan control: and

WHEREAS as part of the former City of Toronto Commissioner of Urban Development Services' approval of plans for the development of 330-338 Davenport Road it was necessary to widen certain lanes in the public lane system bound by Davenport Road, Bedford Road and Dupont Street

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane system in the block bounded by Davenport Road, Bedford Road and Dupont Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parcel 17-4 in the Register for Section M-52.

Being parts of Lots 17 and 18 on Plan M-52 and parts of Lots 1 and 2 on Plan M-535 designated as PART 4 on Plan 66R-17879, all of the said Plans being in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario.
