BY-LAW No. 161-2000

To amend By-law No. 81-89, entitled “A by-law to regulate the height and description of lawful fences”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule “1” of By-law No. 81-89, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns “A”, “B” and “C” of the Schedule the following:

Column A	Column B	Column C
478 Main Street	Section 2.1.2	The section of fence extending from the rear of the house, abutting the deck and garden area and connecting to the line fence located on the south property line, is permitted to have a maximum height of 2.98 metres above grade immediately adjacent to the house, tapering down to a maximum height of 2.83 metres above grade at a distance of 2.74 metres from the house, provided that the portion of the fence exceeding 1.9 metres above grade shall consist of lattice only.
478 Main Street	Section 2.3.2	The section of fence extending from the rear of the house, abutting the deck and garden area and connecting to the line fence located on the south property line, is permitted to have a maximum height of 2.98 metres above grade immediately adjacent to the house, tapering down to a maximum height of 2.83 metres above grade at a distance of 2.74 metres from the house.
