BY-LAW No. 196-2000

To amend By-law No. 209-1999, a By-law “To effect interim control on certain lands in the former Village of Claireville (Etobicoke)” by extending the term thereof from one year to eighteen months.

WHEREAS Council on April 15, 1999 passed By-law No. 209-1999, a by-law “To effect interim control on certain lands in the former Village of Claireville (Etobicoke)”; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 209-1999 is in effect for a period of one year from April 15, 1999; and

WHEREAS Section 38 of the Planning Act permits the Council of a municipality to amend an interim control by-law to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of passage of the interim control by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 209-1999, a by-law “To effect interim control on certain lands in the former Village of Claireville (Etobicoke)” is amended by deleting from Section 4 the words “one year” and substituting for them the words “eighteen months”.
