BY-LAW No. 210-2000

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400,
Traffic and Parking, respecting Commissioners Street, Don Roadway, Leslie Street,
Saulter Street South, Villiers Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule VIII (Prohibited Turns) in §400-61, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Commissioners Street between Don Roadway and Leslie Street	Eastbound and Westbound	U-turns	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in §400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Don Roadway	Both	Commissioners Street and Lake Shore Boulevard East	Anytime
Commissioners Street	South	Don Roadway and Leslie Street	Anytime
