CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 212-2000

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation
of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Lake Shore Boulevard East (M.T. 2)	Between the west curb line of Leslie Street and a point 30.5 metres east of the east curb line of Leslie Street

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Commissioners Street	Between the west curb line of Don Roadway and a point 30.5 metres east of the east curb line of Don Roadway
Leslie Street	Between the south curb line of Commissioners Street and a point 30.5 metres north of the north curb line of Commissioners Street
Leslie Street	Between the north curb line of Lake Shore Boulevard East and a point 30.5 metres south of south curb line of Lake Shore Boulevard East
