BY-LAW No. 213-2000

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law
“To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”,
being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XII (One-Way Streets) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, following the words “Knight Street”, “Mortimer Avenue to Sammon Avenue”, “Anytime” and “Southbound”, where they appear in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Krawchuk Lane	The south limit of the Post Office access to Millwood Road	Anytime	Southbound

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
