BY-LAW No. 219-2000

**Being a by-law to further amend Scarborough Zoning By-law No. 10217, the
Agricultural Holding By-law, as amended.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the Planning Act;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

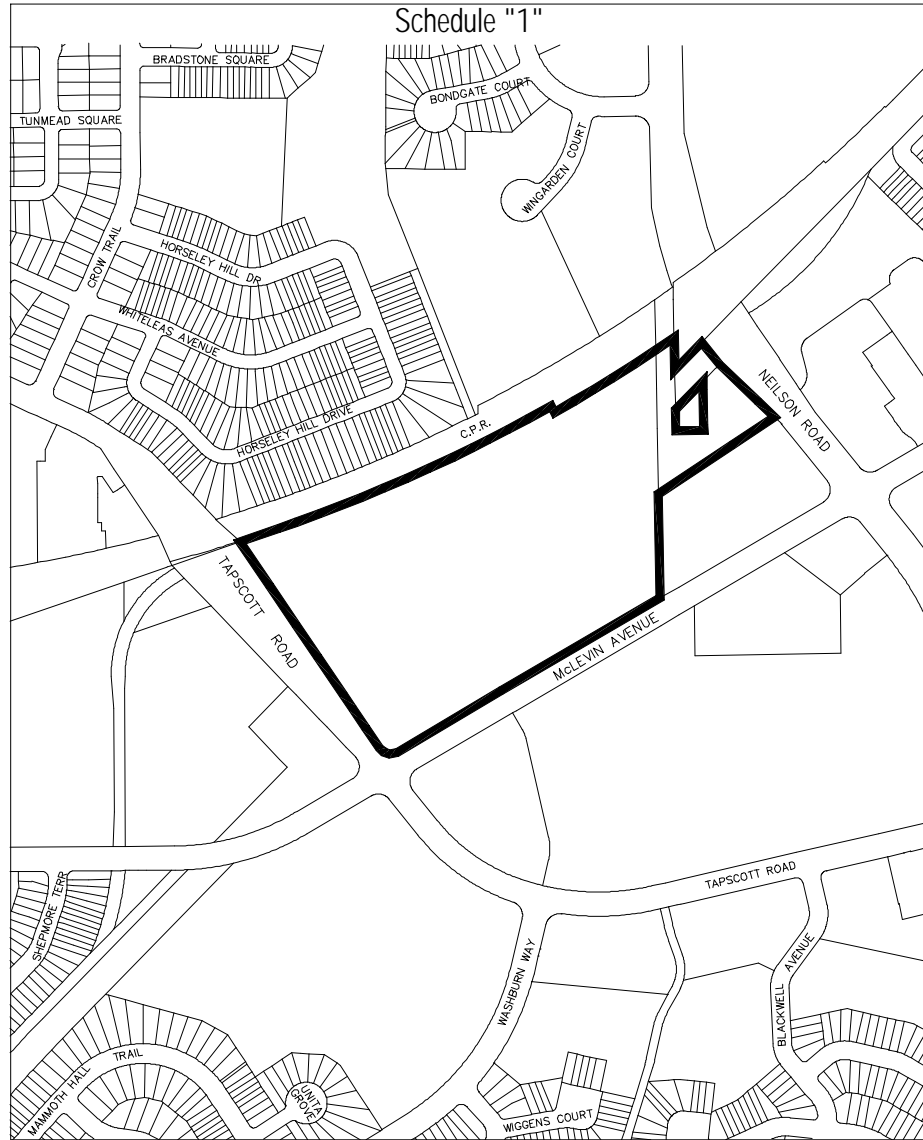
- 1.** The provisions of the Agricultural Holding By-law No. 10217 shall not apply to the lands outlined on the attached Schedule "1".
- 2.** This By-law shall not come into effect until Zoning By-law No. 116-2000 is in full force and effect.
