CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 268-2000

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 109-86, respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law “To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain Metropolitan Roads”, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound and 90 kilometres per hour southbound, between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and Highway No. 404

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound, between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and a point approximately 140 metres south of Lawrence Avenue East

90 kilometres per hour

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound, between a point approximately 140 metres south of Lawrence Avenue East and a point approximately 760 metres north of Lawrence Avenue East

60 kilometres per hour

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), northbound, between a point approximately 760 metres north of Lawrence Avenue East and Highway No. 404

90 kilometres per hour

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), southbound, between the Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway and a point approximately 500 metres south of Lawrence Avenue East

90 kilometres per hour

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), southbound, between a point approximately 500 metres south of Lawrence Avenue East and a point approximately 550 metres north of Lawrence Avenue East

60 kilometres per hour

(In Column 1)

(In Column 2)

Don Valley Parkway (M.T. 201), southbound, between a point approximately 550 metres north of Lawrence Avenue East and Highway No. 404

90 kilometres per hour

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing June 10, 2000.
