**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 277-2000**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Kingston Road at the entrance to the City Home Development approximately 50 metres east of Woodbine Avenue (M.T. 4)	Eastbound and Southbound	Left	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays
