BY-LAW No. 328-2000

**To amend further By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough,
respecting the regulation of traffic on Toronto Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Port Royal Trail	North	Brimley Road (South Intersection)	Lorna Rae Boulevard Anytime

2. Schedule XI (No Standing) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Brimorton Drive	North	Orton Park Road	53 metres west of Orton Park Road Anytime

3. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Oakridge Drive and Allister Avenue	Oakridge Drive
Oakridge Drive and Randall Crescent	Oakridge Drive
