BY-LAW No. 351-2000

**To amend former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, being a By-law
“To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII

1. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting from Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

St. Marks Road	South	A point 30 metres east of Humbercrest Boulevard and Jane Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

NO PARKING – SCHEDULE VIII

2. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
St. Mark’s Road	South	A point 30 metres east of Humbercrest Boulevard and a point 73 metres east thereof	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday
St. Mark’s Road	South	A point 103 metres west of Jane Street and Jane Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

NO STOPPING – SCHEDULE IX

3. That Schedule IX of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

St. Mark's Road	South	A point 103 metres east of Humbercrest Boulevard and a point 103 metres west of Jane Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday
