BY-LAW No. 367-2000

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation
of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Laird Drive and Vanderhoof Avenue (M.T. 41)	Eastbound	Left	Anytime

2. Schedule XVI (Compulsory Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Laird Drive (M.T. 41)	Vanderhoof Avenue, west of Laird Drive	Vanderhoof Avenue, east of Laird Drive
Laird Drive (M.T. 41)	Vanderhoof Avenue, east of Laird Drive	Vanderhoof Avenue, west of Laird Drive
