**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 383-2000**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways to relocate the bicycle lanes on Queens Quay West between Lower Portland Avenue and Lower Bathurst Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from the list of bicycle lanes in §194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Queens Quay West	North, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Spadina Avenue and Portland Street
Queens Quay West	South, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Portland Street and Bathurst Street

B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in §194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Queens Quay West	North, adjacent to curb	Lower Spadina Avenue and Lower Portland Street
Queens Quay West	South, adjacent to curb	Lower Portland Street and Bathurst Street
