CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 403-2000

To amend further By-law No. 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto respecting pensions and other benefits.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 13(1.2) of By-law No. 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law “To provide pensions for employees, their spouses and children of the Metropolitan Corporation and other participating employers”, as such subsection was re-enacted by By-law No. 376-1999 and amended by By-law No. 670-1999, is further amended by

- (a) striking out the text “and 2000” in the last line of the marginal note thereof and substituting therefor “to 2001”;
- (b) striking out the text “and 2000” in the first line thereof and substituting therefor “, 2000 and 2001”.

2. The said By-law No. 15-92, as heretofore amended, is further amended by adding thereto the following section:

“General Pensioner Increase (2000) **42.9** (1) Save and except for those pensions increased pursuant to subsection (2), the amount of pension payable under this By-law is hereby increased by 2.6 per cent. effective the 1st day of January, 2000, in respect of

- (a) each pensioner in receipt of a pension; and
- (b) each employee member entitled to a deferred pension under clause 28(1)(a) and, if applicable, clause 28(4)(b), or predecessors thereof,

on or before the 31st day of December, 1998.

Adjusted Pensioner Increases (2000) (2) Effective the 1st day of January, 2000, the amount of pension

- (a) payable
- (i) to each employee pensioner in receipt of a pension; and

- (ii) to each pensioner under section 29 or a predecessor thereof in respect of a deceased employee member who died prior to retirement; and

which commenced on a date shown in Column I;

- (b) payable to each pensioner under section 31 or any predecessor thereof in respect of a deceased employee pensioner whose retirement commenced on a date shown in Column I;
- (c) payable to each employee member entitled to a deferred pension under clause 28(1)(a) and, if applicable, clause 28(4)(b), as a result of termination of employment which took place after December 1, 1998, on a date shown in Column I, treating any such termination which occurred on any day of a month other than the first as if it had occurred on the first day of the next following month,

is hereby increased by the percentage set out opposite such date in Column II:

Column I	Column II
January 1, 1999	2.600 per cent.
February 1, 1999	2.383 per cent.
March 1, 1999	2.167 per cent.
April 1, 1999	1.950 per cent.
May 1, 1999	1.733 per cent.
June 1, 1999	1.517 per cent.
July 1, 1999	1.300 per cent.
August 1, 1999	1.083 per cent.
September 1, 1999	0.867 per cent.
October 1, 1999	0.650 per cent.
November 1, 1999	0.433 per cent.
December 1, 1999	0.217 per cent.”

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment and passing.

ENACTED AND PASSED by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting this 6th day of July, A.D. 2000.
