**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 440-2000**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Barker Avenue and Woodmount Avenue” and “Barrington Avenue and Secord Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Intersections	Column 2 Stop Streets
Barrington Avenue and Doncaster Avenue	On Barrington Avenue north of Doncaster Avenue
Barrington Avenue and Doncaster Avenue	On Barrington Avenue south of Doncaster Avenue

2. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Parkhurst Boulevard and Cameron Crescent” and “Parkhurst Boulevard and Fleming Crescent” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Intersections	Column 2 Stop Streets
Parkhurst Boulevard and Donegall Drive	On Donegall Drive north of Parkhurst Boulevard
Parkhurst Boulevard and Donegall Drive	On Donegall Drive south of Parkhurst Boulevard
Parkhurst Boulevard and Donegall Drive	On Parkhurst Boulevard east of Donegall Drive
Parkhurst Boulevard and Donegall Drive	On Parkhurst Boulevard west of Donegall Drive

3. This By-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
