**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 513-2000**

**To exempt part of the lands commonly known as 665 Trethewey Drive, being certain lots  
within Plan of Subdivision 66M-2340, from the provisions of subsection 50(5)  
of the *Planning Act*.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*,  
R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended,  
shall not apply to the lands described in Schedule "A"; and.
2. That this By-law shall expire twelve months from the day of its passage by  
Council.
