**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 514-2000**

**To acquire certain interests in land for the preservation of an historical building.**

WHEREAS notice of an application to the Council of the City of Toronto for approval to expropriate the interests in land hereinafter described for the preservation of an historical building has been served on the registered owners thereof and has been published pursuant to the provisions of the *Expropriations Act*; and

WHEREAS no notice in writing indicating a desire for a hearing of necessity with respect to such interests has been received and the time for giving such notice has expired;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The expropriation of the interests in land set forth in section 2 is hereby approved.
2. The fee simple interest is hereby expropriated and taken for the preservation of an historical building, pursuant to the provisions of subsection 191(1) of the *Municipal Act*, in the lands municipally known as 6282 Kingston Road, Toronto, Ontario, described as Part of Lot 5, First Concession of the City of Scarborough, being Part of Lot 69 on Registrars' Compiled Plan No. 9887, designated as Part 1 on Plan 64R-12114, City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough).
3. Authority is hereby granted for the signing, sealing and registration in the proper Land Registry Office of the plans showing the lands and interests in land expropriated pursuant to section 2, including the payment of all expenses incidental thereto.
4. The Commissioner of Corporate Services is hereby authorized to sign and serve on the registered owners of the property set forth in section 2 the Notices of Expropriation, Notices of Election as to a Date for Compensation and Notices of Possession as contemplated by the *Expropriations Act*.
5. The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this by-law, and the City Clerk and the City Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that regard, and to affix the corporate seal of the City to all such documents.
