BY-LAW No. 591-2000

A by-law to authorize the City Clerk to enter into agreements with persons interested in using the City's Vote-Counting Equipment.

WHEREAS paragraph 23 of section 207 of the *Municipal Act* authorizes the City Council to pass by-laws providing for the use by any person of any of the City's employees or mechanical equipment of the municipality and for fixing the terms, conditions and charges therefore; and

WHEREAS in accordance with City Council's instructions (Administration Committee Report 5(1); adopted as amended by Council at its meeting of September 28 and 29, 1999), the agreement entered into with Election Systems and Software Inc. for the acquisition of vote-counting equipment allows the City to sublet the vote-counting equipment to other interested parties while the equipment is supervised by City of Toronto staff to ensure its proper use; and

WHEREAS the City now wishes to pursue opportunities to contract out the vote-counting equipment and the services of appropriate City staff;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City Clerk is authorized to enter into agreements for the sub-lease of the City's vote-counting equipment to other municipalities, unions, community organizations and others, and contract services of the Election Services staff who will supervise the use of the equipment, such agreements to be on a profit basis.
