CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 593-2000

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400,
Traffic and Parking, respecting Boardwalk Drive, Joseph Duggan Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule IV (Stop Intersections) in §400-57, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

2. As permitted by Section 286 of the *Municipal Act*, the enactment of this by-law shall not be deemed to be an assumption by the City of the public highways Boardwalk Drive and Joseph Duggan Road so as to render the City liable for the repair or for any damages resulting from non-repair within the meaning of *Municipal Act*, Section 284; nor shall the enactment of this by-law be deemed to be an assumption by the City of those public highways under the provisions of the Wodbine Park Subdivision Agreement between EMM Financial and The Corporation of the City of Toronto dated April 1, 1997, as amended.
