**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 600-2000**

**To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations”, respecting the alteration of Donlands Avenue from Glebeholme Boulevard to Strathmore Boulevard by the installation of road narrowing islands at specified locations.**

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on June 27, July 3, 10 and 17, 2000 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on July 18, 2000 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being “A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations” is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule “B-3” (Pavement narrowing) the following:
